The South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) and the University of South Africa (UNISA), under the Erasmus+ funded [PoMiSA Project](#) (*The Potential for Microcredentials in Southern Africa*) invite nominations for membership in the **National Working Group on Microcredentials**.

This multi-stakeholder Working Group will support the transition from concept to country framework by:

- Advising on the development of a national policy and implementation framework for microcredentials,
- Promoting quality, coherence, and innovation in the evolving microcredential ecosystem, and
- Ensuring that the framework reflects the voices and lived realities of learners, communities, innovators, and education providers.

3. Be willing to contribute consistently to Working Group activities from October 2025 to late 2026.
